



All classes will have 2 judges per arena. For SHTX, Ranching Heritage and NRSHA, results will be based on both judges' combined placing. This show does not count as 2 shows for SHTX. AQHA VRH/special event classes are double judged.


Stalling/RV Refunds

Health Documents

All horses must have a current (within 12 months) negative Coggins. Out of state horses are required to have a Health Certificate within 30 days of travel to cross state lines or an Extended Equine Health Certificate (EECVI).



Entry Info, Awards, Scratches





General Information

Entries open April 1 and all entries are completed online. Entries close April 26. Late entries accepted with \$100 late fee up until noon the day prior of competition.

Scheduling

The show will run 3 to 4 arenas (depending on the day). If you cross-enter divisions that are not concurrent, the likelihood of conflicts are high. It is your responsibility to get to your classes before those classes finish! You must check in with the gate to work out any conflicts. Riders who do not cross enter will have minimal (if any) conflicts. Please keep this in mind as you plan what to enter.

Entry Changes

Class adds must be done at check in. No late entries are accepted after noon the day before the class. Changes must be received either in IN PERSON AT THE SHOW or via the SCRATCH/ADD form. NO TEXTS or EMAILS PLEASE. Any cattle classes scratched after April 26 are responsible for the cattle fee.

Entry Scratches / Refund Policy

For information on stalling refunds, refer to the stalling section.

Entry Scratches by entry deadline, April 26 = full refund

After April 26, cattle fees and office fees are not refundable and will be charged to the card on file.

Class Scratches after check in are non-refundable.

All entry scratches must be received IN PERSON AT THE SHOW or via the SCRATCH/ADD form. NO TEXTS or EMAILS PLEASE. "No-shows" will be automatically charged \$250 or office/cattle fees, whichever is greater. Any refunds for credit card transactions will retain 5% to offset the credit card fees.

Results for each day will be final as of 10am the following day. We strongly encourage exhibitors to check the

score sheets. Score sheets will be posted asap after each class. We double check all addition in the office, but we're not perfect! Any errors or corrections MUST BE REPORTED IN PERSON TO THE OFFICE BY 10AM THE FOLLOWING DAY.

APHA Chrome Cash rewards APHA registered horses for their accomplishments across all divisions entered in the NRSHA Derby with a side pot.

Exhibitors with APHA registered horses must enter the Chrome Cash Incentive side pot by filling out the online Chrome Cash Entry Form and paying the required entry fee. A copy of the APHA registration papers must be uploaded with the Chrome Cash Entry Form, and the owner must be a current APHA member.

- Open: \$750 added + 100% of Chrome Cash entry fees (\$75)
- Amateur: \$500 added + 100% of the Chrome Cash entry fee (\$50)
- Ltd Amateur: \$250 added + 100% of the Chrome Cash fee (\$25)

NRSHA Rules

NRSHA Qualifying, Eligibility & Rules

A horse/rider must show 3 times with an alliance partner in order to qualify to compete in any NRSHA class. For the Open, qualification is on the horse. Qualifying lists are available at www.ranchhorse.net Riders showing with multiple associations to qualify with 3 shows must fill out the Attendance Verification Form on the NRSHA website by March 15 to enter. Complete qualifying information is available at ranchhorse.net.

Riders/horses may enter classes within their qualifying category (Open/Amateur/Youth) for which they meet eligibility requirements. However, cross-entering within a category is not allowed (ie. A rider cannot enter Amateur Ranch Riding and Limited Amateur Ranch Riding, or Limited Youth Reining and Novice Youth Cow Work, etc.) The horse/rider combo must ride within the division they choose. Eligibility is based on AQHA's definition of an Amateur, Youth and VRH rookie as of 1/1/2024. Stallions are not allowed in novice divisions. Riders must have a current membership with their qualifying association.

In the unfortunate event a qualified horse/rider combination is unable to compete due to horse illness or lameness, horse substitutions will be considered with documentation on a case-by-case basis.

Divisions: Open (all age), Amateur, Limited Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth, Limited Youth, Novice Youth

Classes will have 2 judges. Scores will be combined for overall placing and payout. Classes include Cow Work, Reining, Ranch Trail, Ranch Riding and Ranch Cutting. A horse/rider combination is eligible for the all around if it competes in at least one cattle class and all other non-cattle classes in the same division. Points will be awarded to riders based on the number of horses entered in each class, and the horse/rider combination with the most points will be the NRSHA National Champion.

Ownership

Horse ownership rules for youth and amateur refer back to your qualifying association.





Class & Equipment Rules

Riders may ride two handed in a snaffle, hackamore or bosal on any age horse in the novice division. This is only allowed in the novice division. All other AQHA equipment rules apply. Classes follow the rules for AQHA VRH, with a few exceptions:

Open Ranch Cow work - riders have the option to rope or circle. However, any concurrent entries in VRH must rope to fulfill the requirements of that class

Box-Drive - the 5 point penalty implemented in 2025 in NRCHA, APHA and SHTX for a contestant not initiating a turn during the second boxing portion will apply. This penalty replaces the previous OP for this situation.

Ties

Ties in individual classes will remain and points will be split, unless it is a tie for first place. Then Judge 1 is the first tie breaker, Judge 2 is the second tie breaker. If horses remain tied, the tie will be broken on tie breakers designated on the score sheet for Judge 1, and then Judge 2.

Ties in the All Around will be broken based on the highest placing in the Cow Work. If this doesn't break the tie, other classes will be used in the following order: Ranch Cutting, Ranch Reining, Ranch Trail, and Ranch Riding.

All payouts for all events with The Gathering will be mailed from the Lazy E and paid out according to the payout schedule in the SHTX Rule Book. A current W-9 form must be completed in order to receive prize money.
